The CRAFT-ACT ENTREPRENEURSHIP Programme // 2023-2024

The Entrepreneurship and Financial Education Programme within the Craft-Act project is a 20 hour programme designed to empower migrant communities in Turkey by providing them with essential skills for managing and growing small businesses. This programme teaches participants fundamental aspects of entrepreneurship, from financial management and budgeting to marketing strategies and digital payment methods, building a foundation for their own business ventures.

In addition to promoting social integration, the programme aims to enhance participants' economic opportunities by equipping them with practical tools that can be applied in various entrepreneurial fields. By the end of the course, participants not only gain the confidence to launch and manage their own small businesses but also develop greater self-sufficiency and economic independence, paving the way for a sustainable livelihood and community contribution.

## **Aims**

The aim of the Entrepreneurship and Financial Education programme is to empower migrants by equipping them with essential business and financial skills expanding their economic opportunities. Through practical, hands-on training, participants develop both entrepreneurial and financial competencies, enabling them to integrate more fully into their communities and explore new pathways to economic independence
